- Local snapper fillet, lightly coated with dukkah and pan seared served on a smooth

hummus topped with minted yoghurt and herb and onion salad surrounded with a drizzle of pomegranate molasses.

- King Island porterhouse steak, sensational quality beef from King Island cooked to your liking on the chargrill served with parsnip and potato mash, herb and thyme roasted baby swiss brown mushrooms and red wine jus.

Specials from the blackboard:

- Spanish style croquettes and soft shell crab, as an entree.
- North African "Bus Station" Kefta, tasty lamb meat balls with currents, pine nuts and North African Spices simmered in a tasty tomato sauce finished with cracked egg and crusty bread, *...sounds delicious!*

Sticky date pudding, quince crumble and middle eastern pavlova are just some of the great desserts on offer.
